June 3-6 Morning	SLIMY, GOOEY, AND GROSS: This camp involves fun, hands-on activities that teach basic science principles. We'll explore slimy, gooey, and gross science while we conduct all kinds of icky, sticky experiments!	1-3
June 10-14 Morning	LEGO MINDSTORMS® EV3 ROBOTICS: Create a fun LEGO® adventure this summer. Campers will work in teams to construct and program a robot using LEGO Mindstorms® EV3, and compete in exciting challenges all week long.	4-6
June 10-13 Afternoon	LEGO® WEDO ROBOTICS: Design and build LEGO® WeDo robots and then animate your robot with basic programming. Let your imagination run wild as you bring your robot to life in an adventure you write, animate, and perform!	1-3
June 17-20 Morning	ZOMBIE APOCALYPSE: A fun and educational camp to learn how to prepare for natural disasters like a zombie apocalypse. Your training will include a variety of games and fun hands-on activities to help you survive a zombie outbreak.	4-6

Register May 13th or later:	1 camp = \$69 each	2 camps = \$64 each	3 or more camps = \$59 each

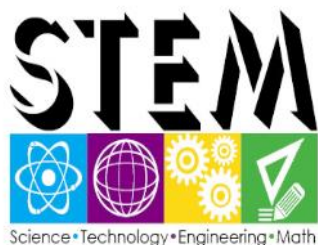
Immediate family members can combine for the discount; however, registration must be completed at the same time.
