Jr. Livestock Scholars Testing Program

2017-18 Jr. Livestock Scholars Program

Weber County 4-H members currently in grades 3-12 have the opportunity to compete in the 4-H Livestock Scholars Testing Program. To participate youth must be CURRENTLY enrolled in 4-H (with fees paid). 4-H members can take the test on any day the 4-H office is open (M-F, 8:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m.) from the **5th through the end of the month**. Once the month ends, members cannot take that month's test. The Jr. Livestock Test Schedule for the current 4-H year can be found [here](#).

- Awards are given for each species in each grade division.
- Each month's tests are prepared for all four species: beef, goat, sheep, and swine.
- Youth can select the test for the species they are studying. They do not have to be raising that species to participate in the test.
- The tests are a combination of true/false, multiple choice, and fill-in-the-blank.
- All the questions for the test come from the Ohio State University Resource manuals, which are available for purchase from the 4-H office.
